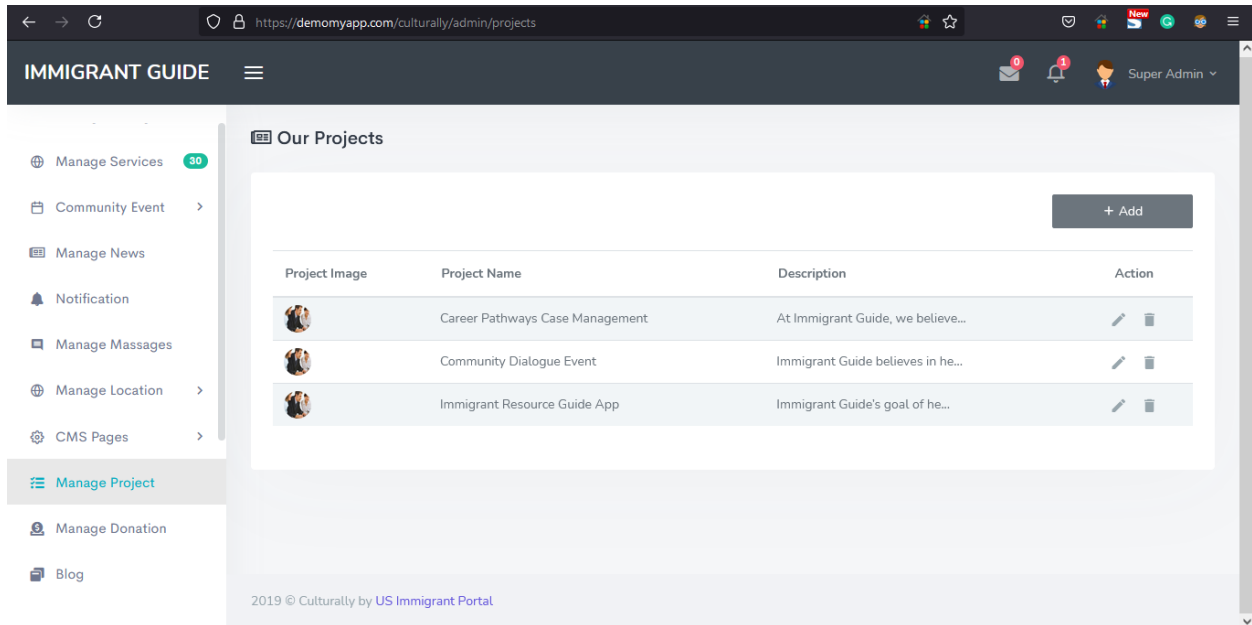
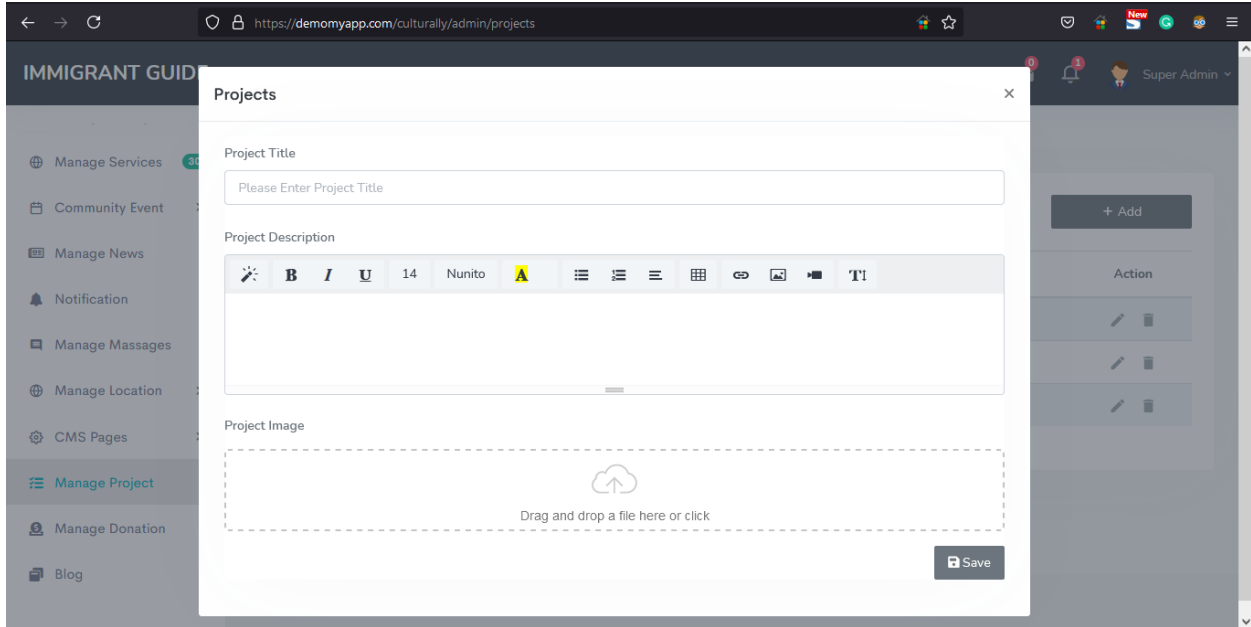


## Immigrant Guide Website Phase 2- Sprint 1- Manual

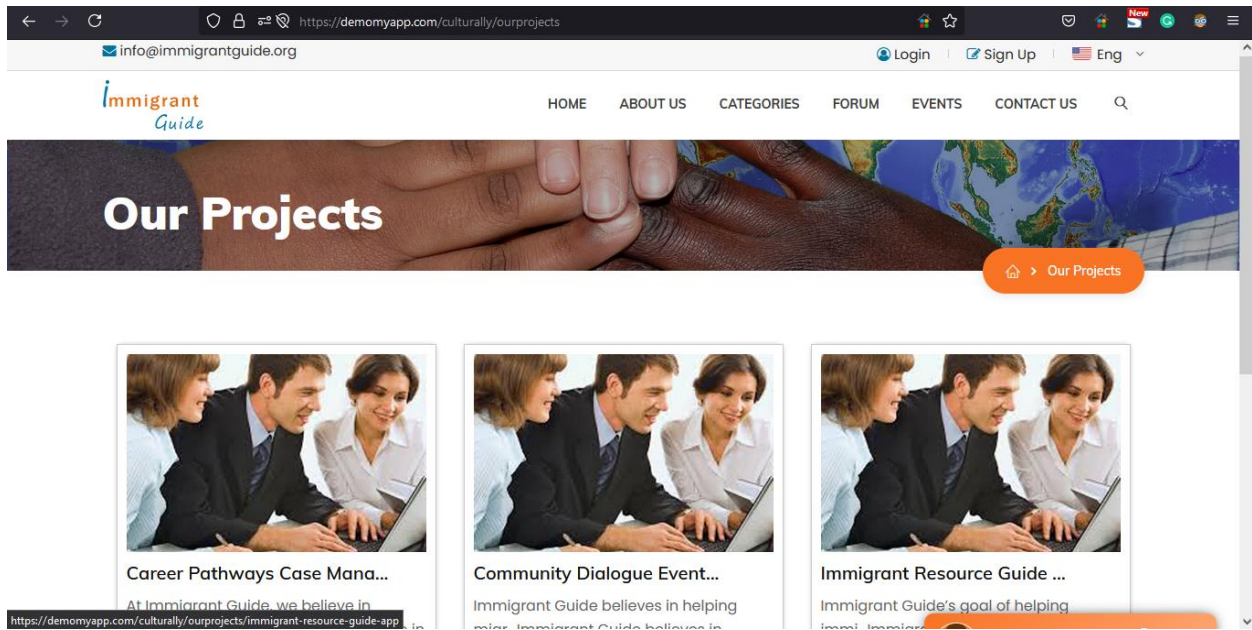
1. We've added an option for the admin where they can add and manage the project.





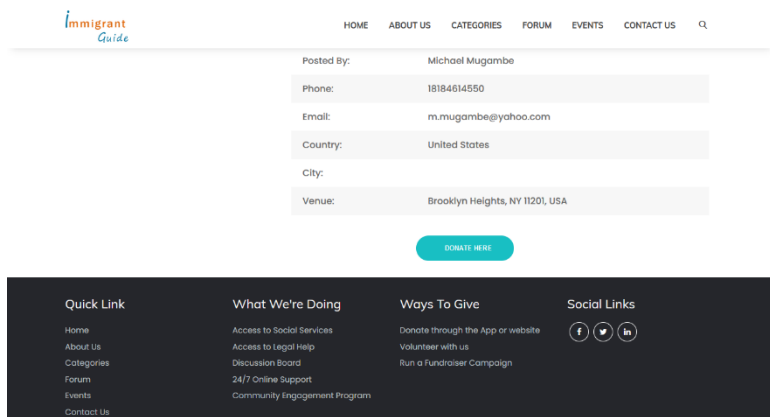
2. All the projects added by the admin shall display once the admin clicks the **Our Projects** button in the slider.





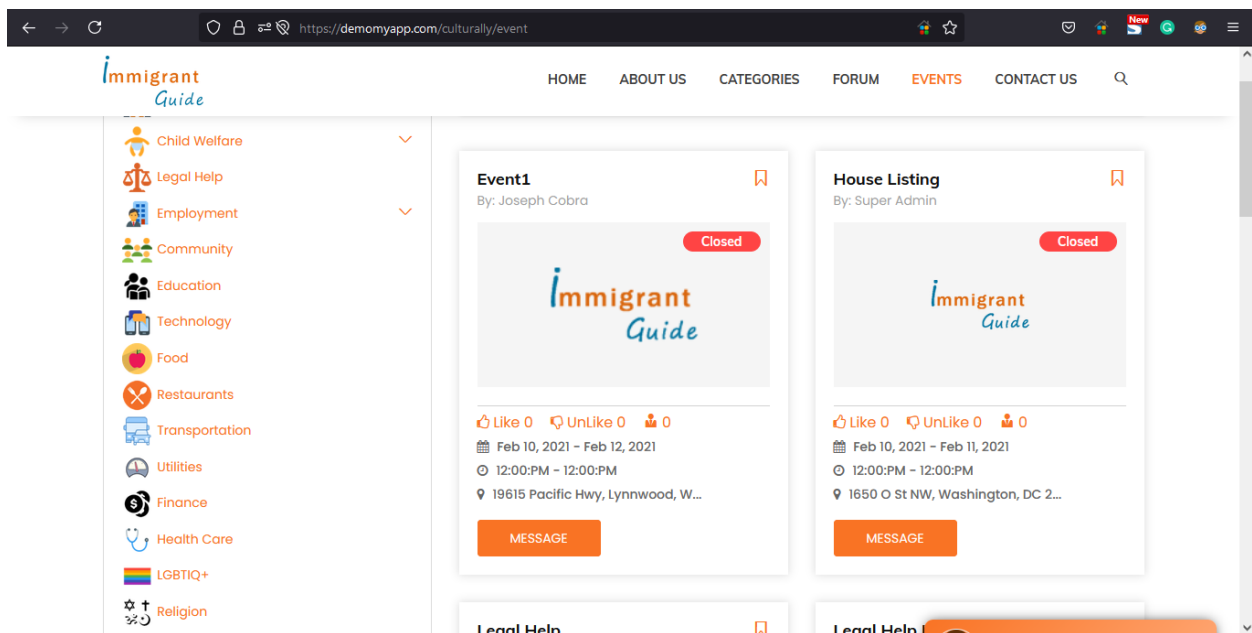

There shall be a Donation button on every event and that shall redirect to the Donation page.

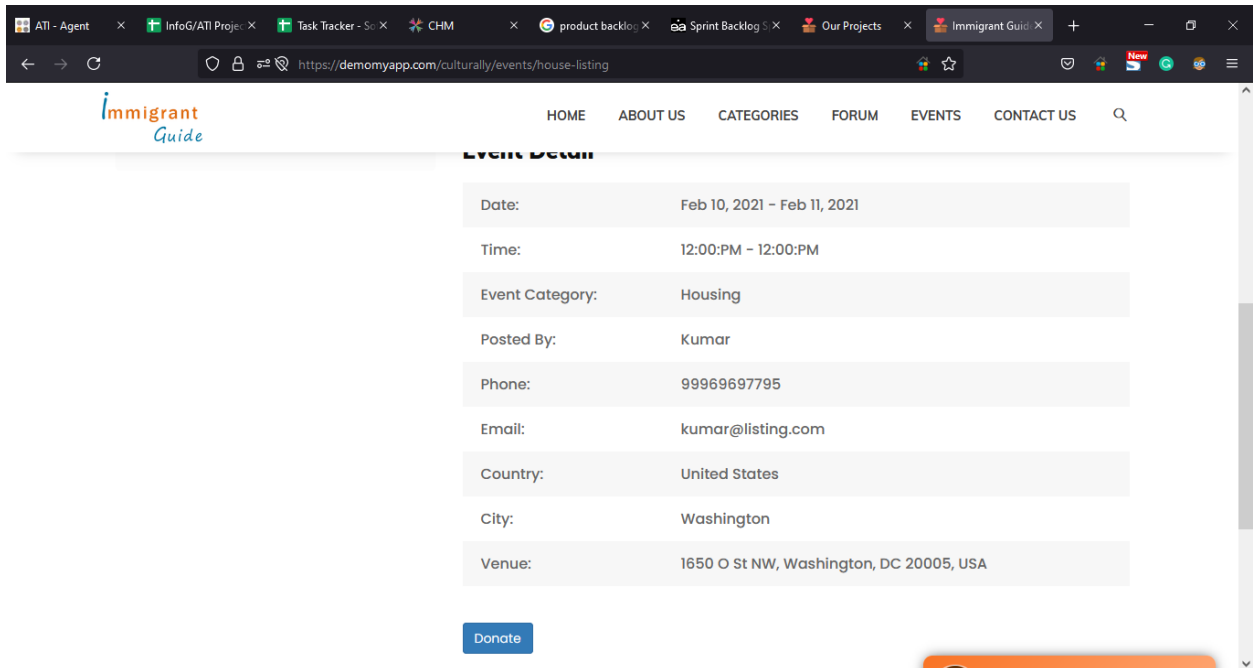


- i. PayPal, Credit card and Debit card payment gateways shall add in the Donation page
- ii. Admin shall manage the details of the donations in the admin panel."

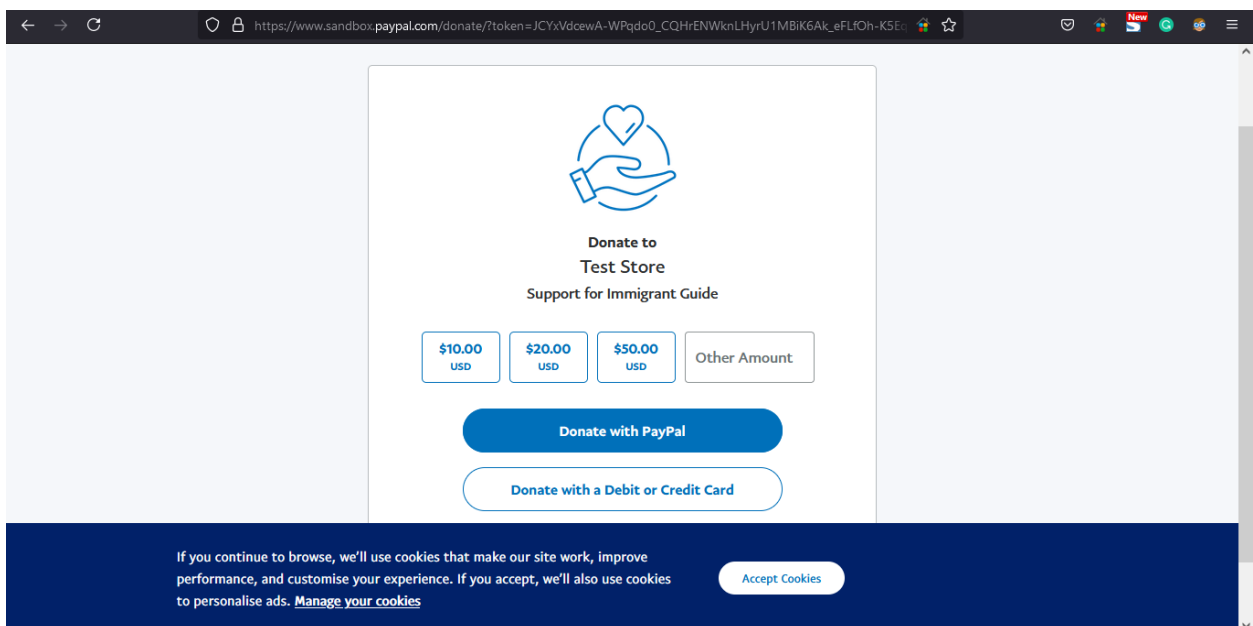
1. When a user clicks the **Community events** button in the slider they'll be able to view the list of events



2. When they click any event and scroll down, they'll be able to view the Donate button

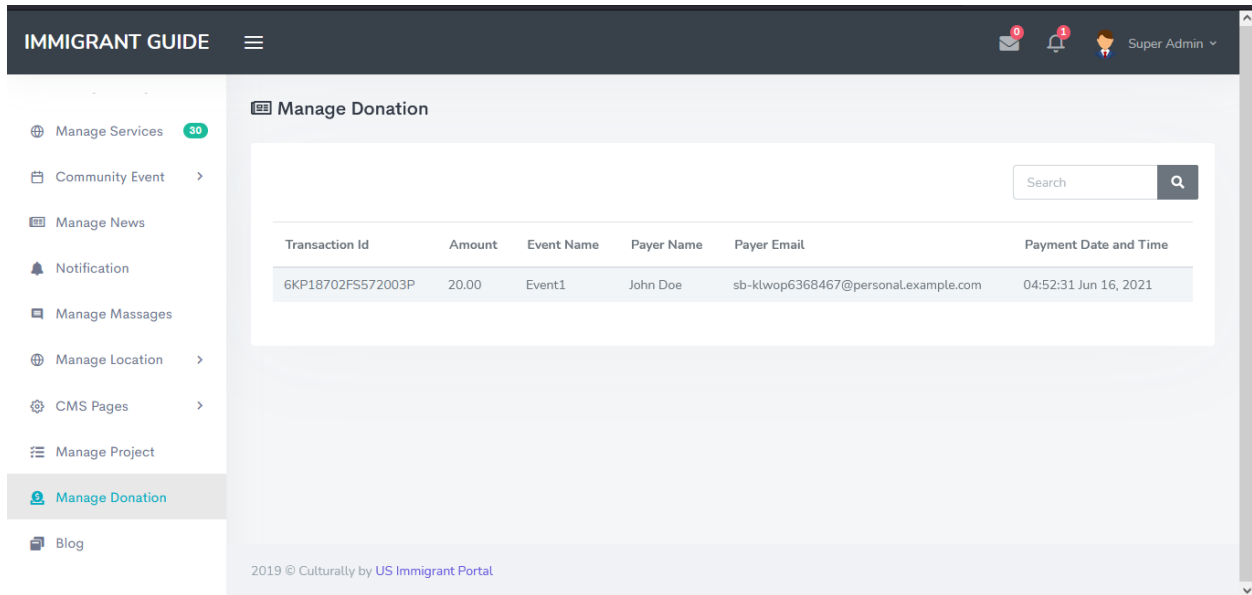


3. Once they click the donate button they shall redirect to the donation page



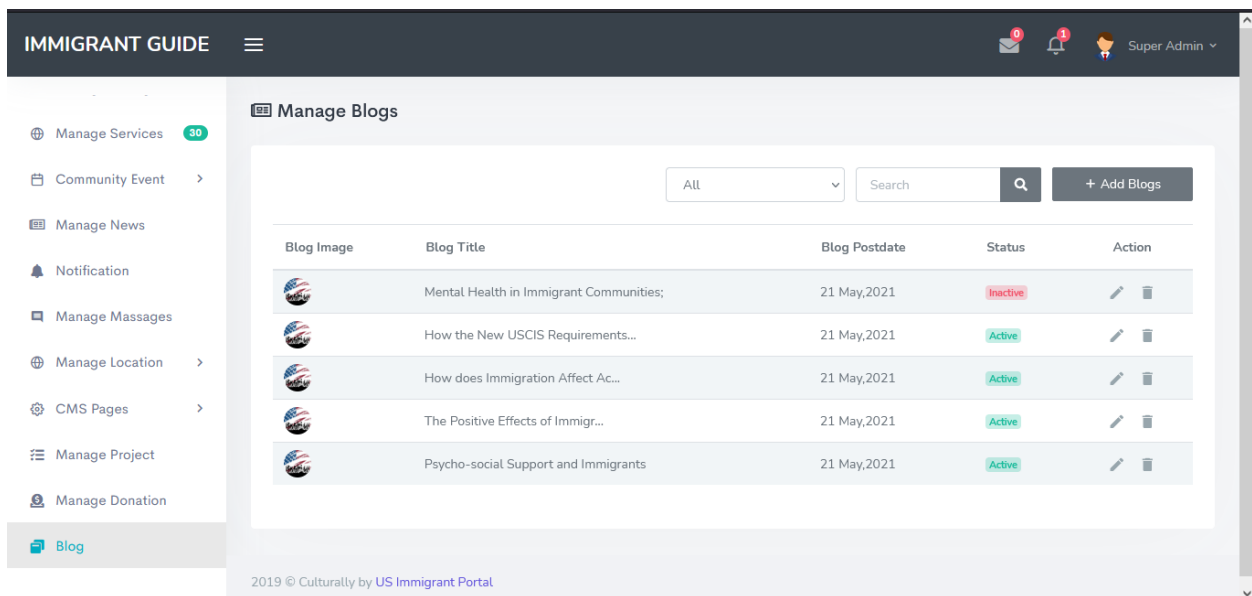
4. The user can donate the amount using the PayPal/ Debit or credit card. Payment integration has been added to the application.

1. Admin can see the list of blogs and they can add a new blog

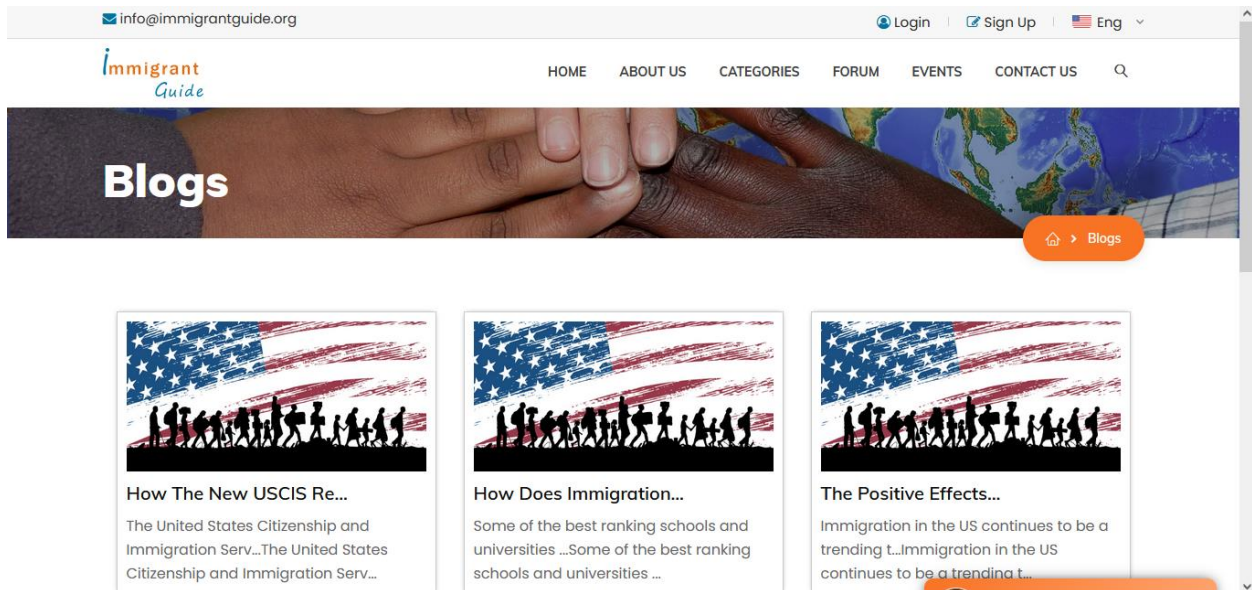
